PAKISTAN-UK BILATERAL TRADE FINANCIAL YEAR

2005/06 – 2010/11

The U.K. remains among Pakistan's top five export destinations with balance of trade in favour of Pakistan. Pakistan's exports to the U.K amounted to £807 Million during FY 2010/11 and indicated a positive growth of approx 14.7% when compared with the FY 2009/10 exports of £703 million. The total trade surpassed £1 billion mark with a growth rate of 18%.

There was a significant export growth seen in fruits, vegetables, cereals, spices, pharmaceutical products, articles of base metal, carpets, cement, musical instruments, articles of apparel & clothing accessories, etc.
