Please find enclosed latest policy dated 13th June 2023 received from the concerned authorities in Pakistan.

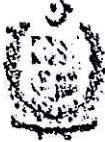
2. In view of the diminishing cases of COVID-19, the concerned authorities in Pakistan have conveyed updated SOPs, including abolition of requirement for mandatory **Covid Vaccine Certificate** as well as **Negative PCR Report** for all passengers travelling into Pakistan.

3. It is, therefore, requested to kindly allow all passengers to board their flight to Pakistan without requirements of COVID vaccine certificate and PCR test.

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

Subject: Updated COVID-19 Policies for inbound passengers

Reference previous letter No.801/A/Ops-III/NCOC-01 dated 9 March 2022

As per directions of competent authority, following policy decisions are made for all inbound passengers travelling in to Pakistan:

- i. The requirement for mandatory COVID-19 vaccine certificate at the time of arrival to Point of entry in Pakistan has been abolished
 - ii. All inbound passengers will NOT be required to present negative PCR report before boarding or on arrival
 - iii. 2% screening for COVID-19 of passengers travelling from UK, Gulf and other countries has been abolished.
 - iv. Enhancing syndromic Surveillance of all passengers arriving at point of entries.
 - v. Strengthening Infection prevention and control practices to contain the transmission of pathogen at point of entries
2. All the above-mentioned policies shall be implemented with immediate effect until further orders.
