23RD MARCH, 2024

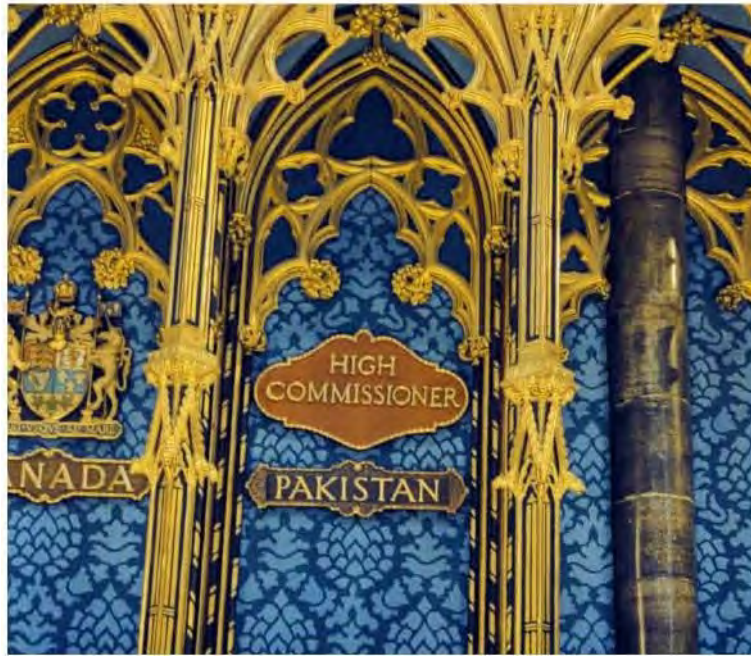

PAKISTAN DAY RECEPTION AT PAKISTAN HOUSE, LONDON

23RD MARCH 2024

The National Day Reception was held in advance (23rd March) due to the date falling in the holy month of Ramazan.

While paying glowing tributes to our elders who led the struggle for Pakistan, the High Commissioner said that, "Our Founding Fathers articulated a remarkable vision for Pakistan. that transcended mere words; it encapsulated the collective aspirations of millions, setting the foundations for the birth of our beloved homeland." Dr. Mohammad Faisal added that a newly elected government had taken charge in Pakistan, heralding a pivotal advancement in Pakistan's democratic journey. FOREIGN MINISTER, MOHAMMAD ISHAQ DAR'S VISIT TO UNITED KINGDOM



MEETING WITH UK MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOUTH ASIA AND COMMONWEALTH

22ND MARCH, 2024

Foreign Minister, Mohammad Ishaq Dar met with the UK Minister of State for South Asia and Commonwealth, Lord Tariq Ahmad at FCDO in London.

Lord Ahmad felicitated Foreign Minister Dar on assuming the position of Foreign Minister and expressed the desire to work closely with the new government.

The two Ministers discussed measures to further deepen bilateral relations between Pakistan and the United Kingdom including leveraging the untapped potential of the British Pakistani diaspora and to further expand trade and investment opportunities. The resumption of PIA flights to the United Kingdom was also discussed. Foreign Minister Dar expressed wishes for complete health and recovery for His Majesty, King Charles III and for the Princess of Wales.

MEETING WITH UK MINISTER OF STATE FOR DEVELOPMENT

22ND MARCH, 2024

Foreign Minister Mohammad Ishaq Dar met with the UK Minister of State for Development Andrew Mitchel MP at FCDO in London. Pakistan - UK relations, Pakistan's engagement with multi-lateral fora, Pakistan's economic development vision of the new government came under discussion. The two Ministers underscored the deep bonds of friendship between Pakistan and the UK and agreed to deepen bilateral relations, particularly in trade and investments. The Foreign Minister said that he is looking forward to the visit of Andrew Mitchel to Pakistan.



INTERACTION WITH OFFICERS OF PAKISTAN HIGH COMMISSION, LONDON

20TH MARCH, 2024

"In addition to conventional diplomacy, Pakistan needs to prioritise economic-diplomacy in the current circumstances. In this regard, all missions of Pakistan abroad should focus on attracting investments", stated the Foreign Minister Mr. Mohammad Ishaq Dar while interacting with officers of Pakistan High Commission in London.

The Foreign Minister said that Pakistan is blessed with significant natural as well as high-quality human resources. The country has all the potential to become a great economy provided a coherent approach is adopted to bring fiscal discipline and curtail external deficit. The only requirement of the day is to manage these resources in an effective manner, the Foreign Minister said. He said that all stakeholders, including line ministries, need to work hand-in-hand with a team spirit to strengthen Pakistan both internally and externally. Mr. Dar said that Pakistan is undergoing challenging times, however, the incumbent government is committed to provide relief to the common man. Moreover, on international fronts, Pakistan is engaging with partners for mutual cooperation. Foreign Minister advised the officers to work hard and diligently to bring long-term investments in the country and enhancement of trade.



PRESS CONFERENCE OF THE FOREIGN MINISTER MOHAMMAD ISHAQ DAR

23RD MARCH, 2024

Minister for Foreign Affairs Mohammad Ishaq Dar said the government of Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif would implement a five-year road map to put Pakistan on the road of economic progress and bring down inflation to lessen economic difficulties of the common man.

Addressing a press conference after attending the Nuclear Energy Summit in Brussels, he said the 16-month government of Shehbaz Sharif saved Pakistan from economic collapse after the bad policies of the previous government which devastated the economy of the country.

He also told about his meetings with ministers of the United Kingdom, during which it was agreed that UK government would further invest in development projects in Pakistan. He expressed best wishes for King Charles and Princess of Wales who were diagnosed with cancer.

He said neighbouring countries should eliminate terrorism through mutual cooperation. Responding to a question, he said Pakistan needed to get out of the trap of budget deficit and current account deficit.

He said economic diplomacy was a top priority of the government and the new finance minister Muhammad Aurganbzeb had all the expertise to deal with the economic issues of Pakistan. The minister said the government was trying its best for the resumption of flights of Pakistan International Airlines after meeting all the international requirements for compliance. "We are keen for the resumption of PIA flights and it is a matter of weeks after which flights will be initiated."

MEETING WITH UK SHADOW FOREIGN SECRETARY

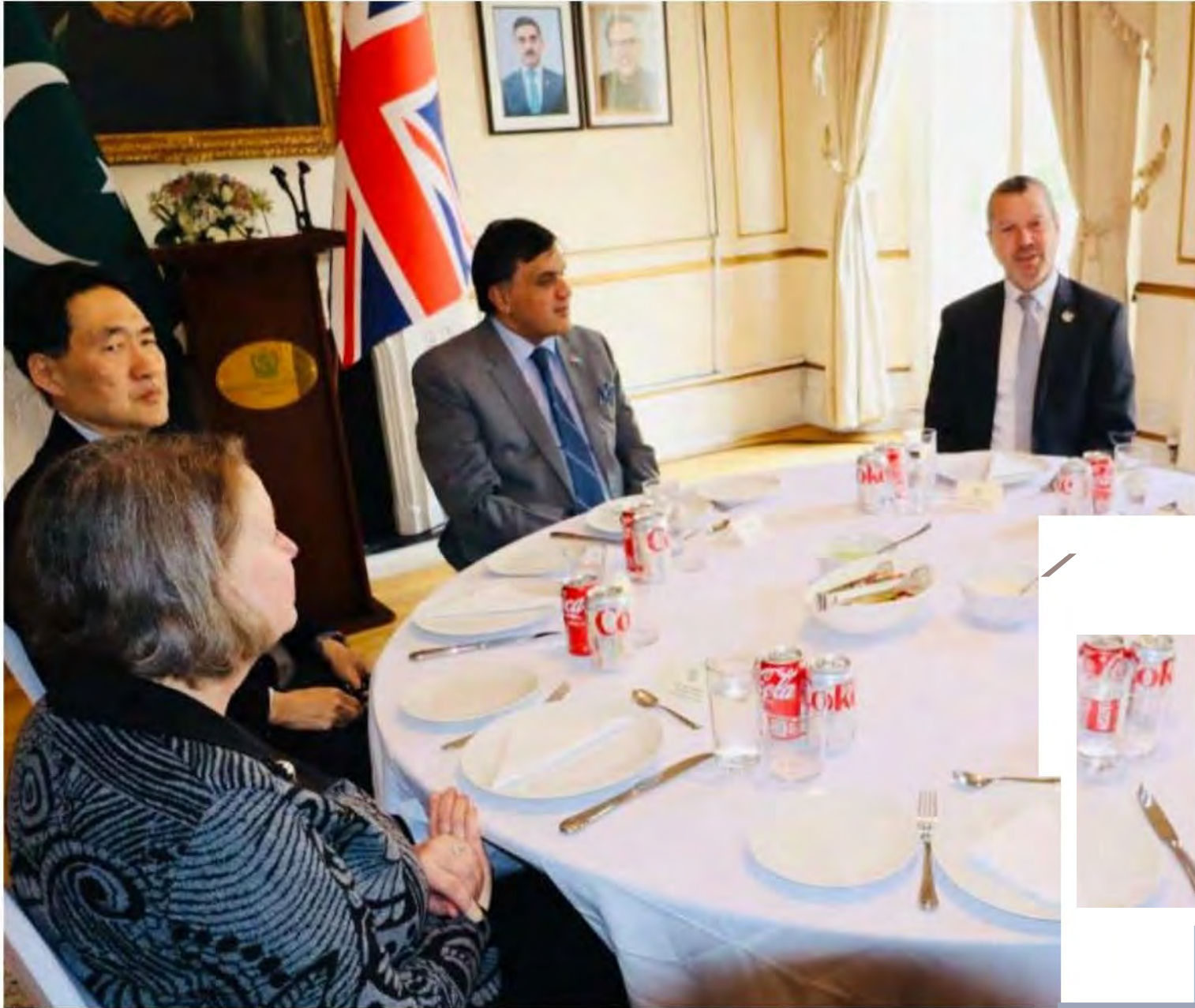
28TH FEBRUARY, 2024

13th FEBRUARY, 2024

The High Commissioner of Pakistan to UK, Dr. Mohammad Faisal along with his wife offered condolences with the family of late Dr. James Shera, former Mayor of Rugby during an impressive memorial service held in Rugby, UK today. Mayor of Rugby, Mrs. Maggie O'Rourke; Deputy Lieutenant of the County of Warwickshire Dr. Eric Wood OBE; Senior officials from Pakistan High Commission, London; family members, and a large number of well wishers & Pakistani diaspora attended the memorial service.



The High Commissioner said, "The death of James Masih Shera has deprived Pakistan and the British Pakistani community of a true friend and a mentor". He was our very own Dr. James Shera who had a selfless devotion to the cause of Pakistan and the community. Paying tribute to Dr. Shera, the High Commissioner said that he was a man of great integrity, hard work and interfaith harmony. Dr. James was gifted with impeccable skills as a mediator and always acted as a bridge to bring people together. Dr. Faisal said that Dr. Shera remained steadfast in public service as Mayor and as a passionate advocate of interfaith harmony. Dr. James Shera breathed his last while he was on a family visit to Pakistan this January. Dr. Shera made history in 1988 when he became the first Pakistani to be elected Mayor of Rugby, and four years later he became one of the first recipients of the prestigious Sitara-i-Imtiaz and then Hilal-e-Quaid-i-Azam in 2023, awarded by the President of Pakistan for services to community and interfaith relations. Dr. Shera was made an MBE in 2007 and a decade later was made an Honorary Freeman of the Borough of Rugby - the highest honour the borough council can bestow. Born in a small rural village in Pakistan, Dr. Shera's journey towards playing a pivotal role in Rugby's public life began when he secured a scholarship to study at the Catholic University of Louvain in Belgium. Friends in the UK led James Shera to England in 1970 and a job at Rugby station as a railway guard. After completing a post-graduate degree at the University of Warwick, he became a teacher at Newbold Middle School, later joining the county council education department where he worked until taking retirement.

"Time has not diminished our resolve and support for Kashmiri brothers and sisters who are facing extreme atrocities at the hands of Indian occupation forces", said High Commissioner of Pakistan to UK Or. Mohammad Faisal. He was speaking at a Seminar arranged today by the Pakistan High Commission, London on the occasion of "Jammu & Kashmir Solidarity Day". He lamented that there are extreme violations of human rights in the Valley, where Indian occupied forces are targeting innocent civilians, including children, with pellet guns, and the number of people going blind has alarmingly increased over the years. "The only solution to Jammu & Kashmir dispute is to grant the right of self determination to the Kashmiris, as per the UN Security Council Resolutions, emphasized the High Commissioner.

CENTRAL LIBRARY OF IMPERIAL COLLEGE LONDON NAMED AFTER DR. ABDUS SALAM, THE FIRST NOBEL LAUREATE FROM PAKISTAN

In a graceful ceremony held at Imperial College London, the central library has formally been named as Abdus Salam Library in honour of the first Pakistani to be awarded Nobel Prize in Physics. High Commissioner of Pakistan in UK, Dr Mohammad Faisal; President of Imperial College, Professor Hugh Brady; family members of Dr. Salam including his two sons Umar Salam and Ahmed Salam, former students and faculty members of Imperial College attended the event. In a statement, Pakistan's High Commissioner Dr. Mohammad Faisal has said that, "Imperial College has honoured the distinguished services of Dr. Abdus Salam by naming central library after him. It is indeed a great honour for Pakistan and his family, being the first Pakistani to be awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics". "Dr. Salam's legacy will continue to provide guidance to students and researchers who are endeavouring to unwind the mysteries of theoretical physics", stated the High Commissioner.
